

Designed and built for diverse environments to PC6 Polar Class standards, both ships feature a new innovative design, incorporating many features that have made Seabourn ships so successful. Two custom-built, 6-seater submarines provide an unforgettable view of the world beneath the ocean's surface, a complement of kayaks and 24 Zodiacs can accommodate all guests at once, allowing for a truly immersive experience... all alongside a crew that includes an outstanding and well-travelled expedition team comprised of highly regarded wilderness experts, scientists, historians and naturalists.

Seabourn Venture's 2026 - 2028 seasons include expeditions to the British Isles, the Arctic, Antarctica and the Northwest Passage - where you may cruise in Zodiacs under teeming bird cliffs, trek to earth-shaking waterfalls and kayak among stately icebergs. View whales, walrus and seals up close, glimpse polar bears in Greenland and cruise in submarines past vivid reef walls and towering underwater ice cliffs.

Seabourn Pursuit winters in Antarctica, then voyages to the distant islands and atolls of the Pacific before summering in Australia's spectacular and rarely visited Kimberley region. Snorkel unspoilt tropical coral gardens glittering with iridescent fish and learn about some of the world's most remote communities on these warm-weather expeditions.

Words are inadequate to fully describe Antarctica, but you'll never forget how this pristine continent makes you feel. Catch your breath as a breaching whale casts up sheets of icy water. Reflect on nature's incredible power as you ride a Zodiac® in the shadow of monumental icebergs. Along the way, let magical moments, celebratory meals and luxurious surroundings fill you with delight.

Your skilled expedition leaders will curate complimentary Zodiac landings at remote islands and beaches, while on optional kayak excursions you may paddle among icebergs, leopard seals and regiments of penguins along untouched beaches. 'Seabourn Moments' include a 'Caviar on the Ice' party, digital photography workshops, open air bouillon and freshly baked treats on deck as you survey the incredible wildlife and scenery.



SOUTH GEORGIA

Feel overwhelmed when landing in South Georgia, a naturalist's paradise. The stunningly beautiful and rugged island is a wildlife sanctuary with over 450,000 pairs of King Penguins, over a million Macaroni Penguins, and many other bird species including albatrosses. Elephant and Fur seals populate most coastlines. History is present all around South Georgia, as seen in the remains of the whaling station which played an important role in early exploration and the island's history.





THE NORTHWEST PASSAGE 2026 & 2027

Embark on the journey of a lifetime through the legendary Northwest Passage and walk in the footsteps of the seafarers and explorers who carved their way through this historic route and through history itself. Surround yourself with the magic of the largest icebergs in the northern hemisphere and abundant sea ice, and indulge your curiosity as you meet the diverse, solitary wildlife that you can only find in this part of the world. Gain a new perspective on life itself as you connect with indigenous communities, learn their rich history and traditions, and better understand what it means to live their self-sustaining way of life.



24-Day Journey across the Northwest Passage

Since Autumn 2023, Seabourn Venture has completed several Northwest Passage voyages, achieving what John Franklin could not, with guests enjoying many once-in-a-lifetime experiences along the way:

- Spotting ten polar bears from the ship in one day enroute to Coningham Bay, lazing, swimming, and eating along the shoreline
- Navigating the Bellot Strait in the company of several bowhead whales
- Exploring Iqaluktuutiaq (also known as Cambridge Bay), an Expedition Team member's hometown, sharing local delicacies, and visiting historic sites such as the original outposts of the Royal Canadian Mounted Police and Hudson's Bay Company
- Hiking Edinburgh Island and revelling in the beauty of the various-coloured mosses and lichens
- Enjoying the all-day open bridge in the Beaufort Sea as the ship passed from Nunavut to Inuvialuit (Canada's North-western Territories) to learn more about the ship's navigation, changing sea ice levels, and historical exploration and shipping routes.


